Contractors with Suspended or Revoked License

This notice serves to inform the public of contractors operating on Guam who have had their licenses suspended or revoked by the Contractors License Board.

Consequences of hiring an unlicensed contractor a contractor with a suspended or revoked license:

- Potential for unsafe and substandard work: Projects may not meet building codes and safety standards, posing risk to occupants.
- Loss of warranty or insurance coverage: Homeowners may not be eligible for warranties or insurance claims if work was performed by an unlicensed or suspended contractor.
- **Difficulty in resolving disputes:** It may be difficult to resolve disputes or obtain compensation for damages if the contractor is unlicensed or suspended.

How to verify contractor licensing:

- Check the Contractors License Board website: www.clb.guam.gov
- Request proof of current licensure from the contractor: Contractors are required to provide proof of license upon request.

Important Note: It is the responsibility of homeowners and property owners to verify the licensure status of any contractor they are considering hiring.
